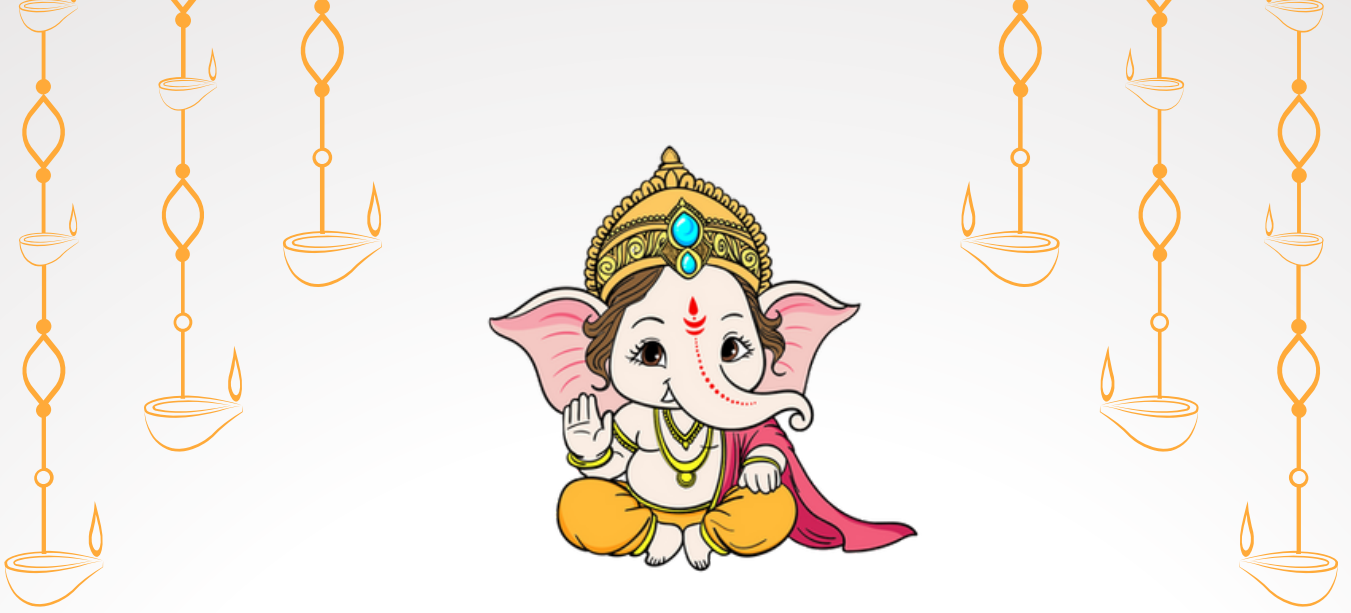
## Independence Day Celebration: A Tribute to the Spirit of Freedom

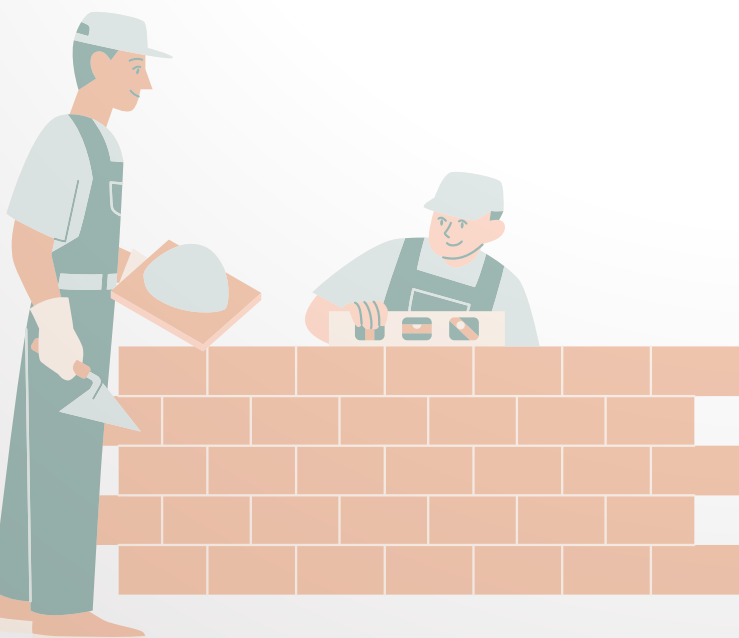


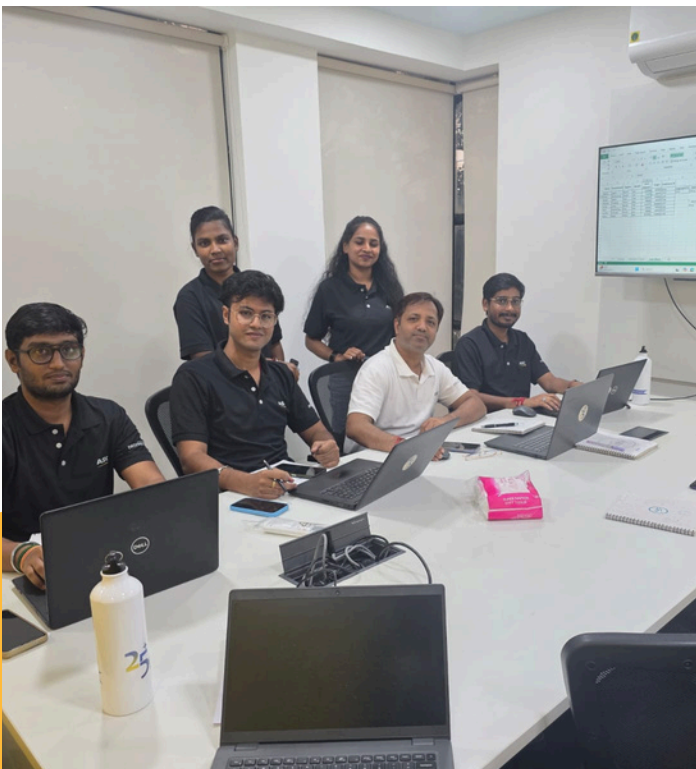

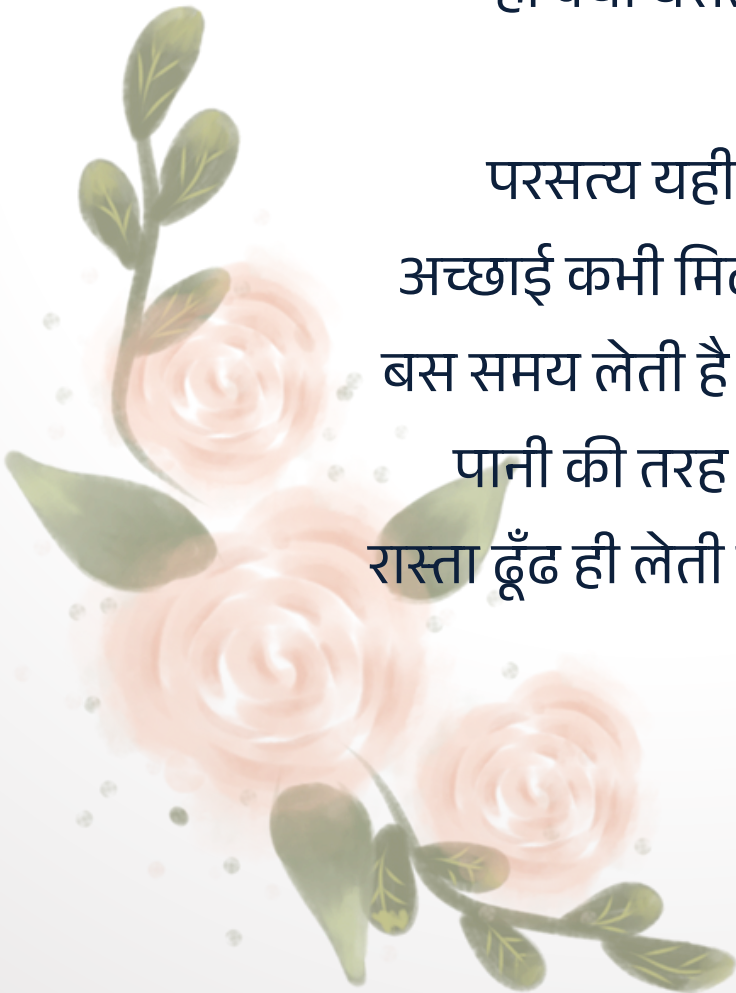

# The Art of Getting “BORED”

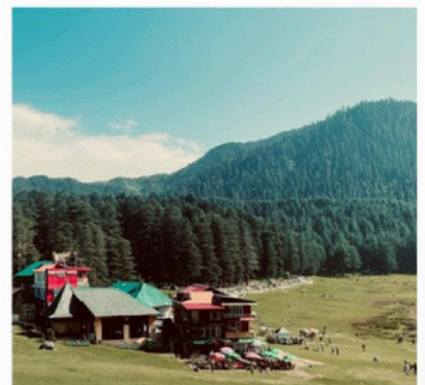

## **TRIP TO DALHOUSIE!!**

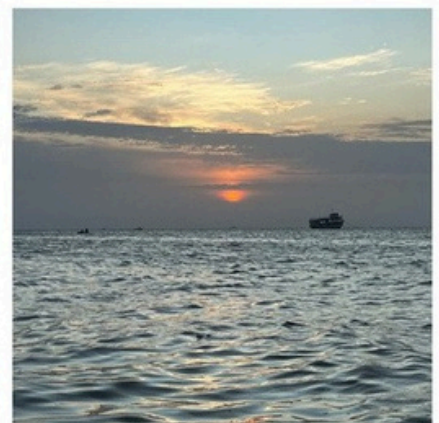
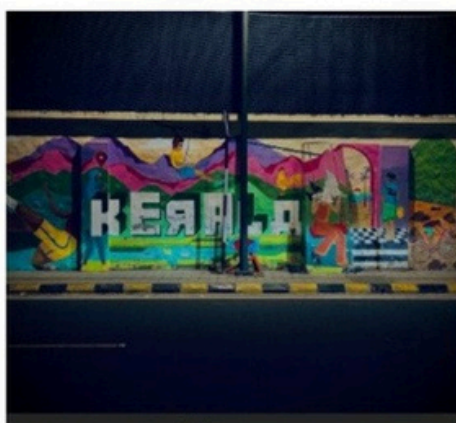
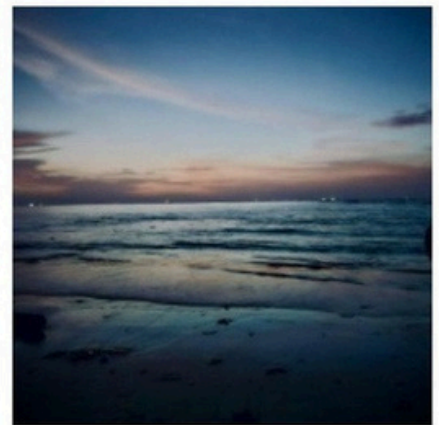
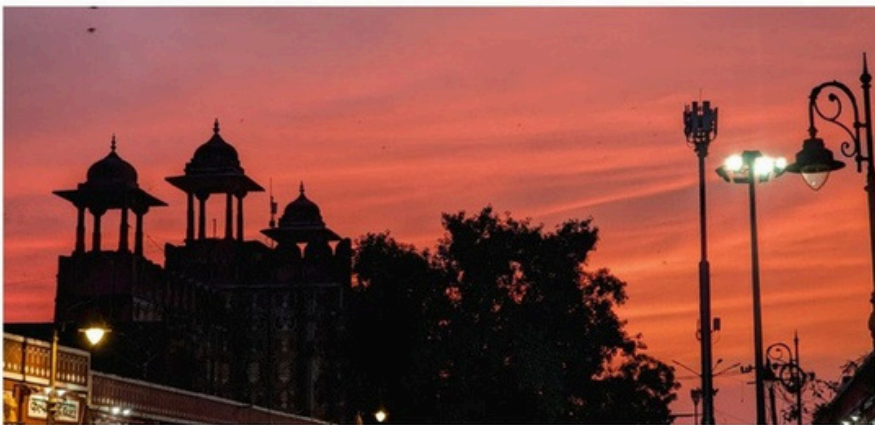
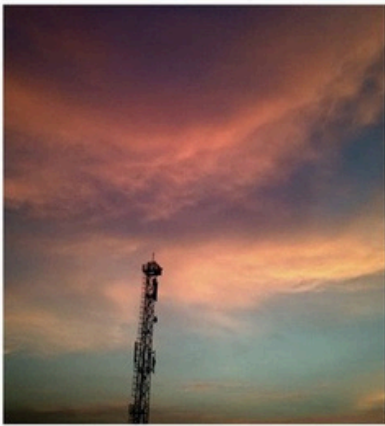

## The HedgeHog Concept (Simplicity between the three circles)

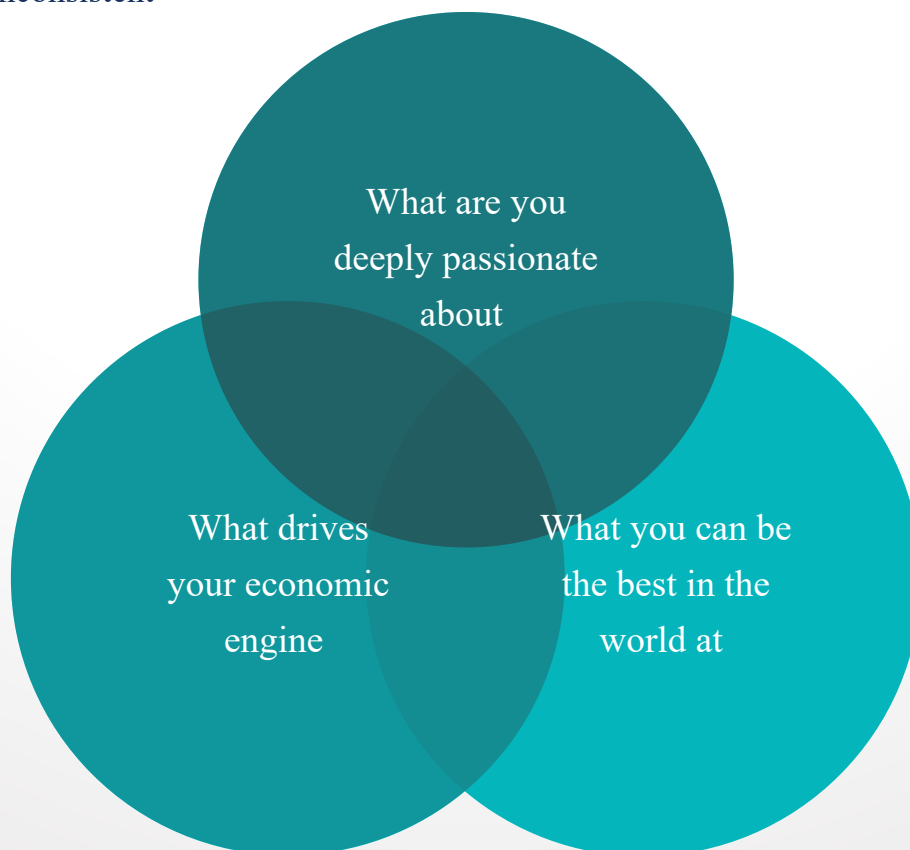
**Focus on one simple, unifying concept, everything else is irrelevant**


