China's new border law and India

China brought the new border law at a time when there has been a border dispute with India for more than a year.

However, no clear reason has been indicated in this law. Nevertheless, many reasons are being given by experts, such as-

Some scholars believe that China has constantly kept an eye on the return of the Taliban to power in Afghanistan and has brought a new border law keeping this in mind, while some scholars believe that China is skeptical about the fact that in Xinjiang province Islamic extremists belonging to Vigar Muslims can cross the border and come here.

At the same time, some experts see it by linking it to the India-China border dispute.

By the way, any of the above reasons have not been clarified in this law, even what effect this law will have on China's border security has not been clarified.

What is land boundary law?

1. China has linked border defense with its sovereignty and territorial integrity.

On this, experts are of the opinion that "It is not necessary that China should make any changes in its border security, but this law definitely shows confidence about China's border security."

2. The second important thing that has been made in the law is that the military can close its borders in the event of a conflict or war that threatens the border security. The law also focused on improving 'construction works' in border areas.

In the new law, along the border, construction in 'border areas', improving work operations and strengthening support capacity for construction have also been included.

3. In the border areas, China can take appropriate steps to strengthen border security, cooperation in economic and social development, strengthen public services and infrastructure.

How worrying for India?

China-Pakistan agreement was signed in 1963, which was a temporary agreement, but China-Pakistan friendship is also well known. Also, China has signed border agreements with 12 of all its 14 neighboring countries. And Bhutan has in the past reached an agreement on a border dispute-related matter, in which it has been emphasized that both countries will reach a settlement of the border dispute through dialogue.

In such a situation, now India is the only neighboring country with which the border dispute is continuously deepening. In this circumstance, this law definitely creates a bit of a doubtful situation for India.

At the same time, senior journalist **Ghazala Wahab** says, "India was thinking so far that the border dispute with China would be resolved through dialogue. But China raised its level to a great extent by linking the 'border dispute' with its 'sovereignty'. Now talks will not solve the whole matter. Now the solution will come out only on 'China's terms'. Whatever 'offer' China will give to India, if India accepts it, then fine, otherwise whatever China wants to do He can, including the option of war."

If their words are taken into account, then it seems that this law is a matter of concern for India, and India should prepare itself ready to deal with every situation in time.

Well, the reality and effectiveness of this law will be seen with time, but having full faith in a neighboring country like China would be the biggest mistake. Therefore, the reality is that India also has to be ready to deal with every situation at its level.
