Remembering Sir Fali S. Nariman: An Inspiration to Young Lawyers

The legal fraternity mourned the loss of Sir Fali S. Nariman, who passed away in February 2024. Renowned for his profound contributions to Indian jurisprudence, Sir Nariman's legacy extends far beyond his legal acumen. He was a beacon of inspiration for countless young lawyers, his expressions and insights about law and the Constitution serving as guiding lights in their professional journeys.

After graduating from the Government Law College, Mumbai in 1950, Nariman began his practice at the Bombay High Court. He was designated as a Senior Advocate in 1961. n 1971, Nariman was appointed as Additional Solicitor General by the Indira Gandhi government. For his contributions to the field of law, Nariman was awarded the Padma Bhushan in 1991 and the Padma Vibhushan in 2007.



One of the most memorable aspects of Sir Nariman's legacy was his mentorship. He believed in nurturing the next generation of legal minds and was always willing to share his wisdom. His lectures and writings were not just technical discourses but also reflections on the ethical dimensions of law. He encouraged young lawyers to view the Constitution not merely as a legal document but as a living entity that evolves with society.


