



#### My journey at ASC Group

My journey at ASC Group began in June 2023 when I joined as an intern in the Insolvency Vertical. Prior to this role, I worked as a lawyer at the Delhi High Court, serving as a junior to an Additional Standing Counsel for crime, and at a legal firm in South Delhi. I practiced law daily, representing clients in court. Transitioning from that environment to being an intern in a completely new setting was a significant change for me. While the postgraduate Insolvency Programme at NLU Bhopal had prepared me and took me back to a collegiate atmosphere, one is never fully prepared for new-world experiences.



Upon joining ASC, it took me some time to settle in. After about

two weeks, I gained a better grasp of the cases and the work involved. My days were filled with drafting documents and ensuring compliance. Initially, I struggled to understand the importance of timely email responses and the impact of CC or BCC in communications. I had to let go of the typical attitude of a lawyer, where everything centered around courtroom representation and handling legal interpretations. Despite my experience arguing in courts, the insolvency vertical revealed how little I knew about this other side of the legal world to which I belonged, at least at that time.

The office's yellow-themed décor was vibrant, yet by evening, it often resulted in hazy visuals. Credit goes to the team, who within four months, helped me adapt to this new challenge. Learning became more manageable, though accompanied by the daily panic of completing tasks to be uploaded (TMS). Remembering to sign in even if I arrived before 09:30 was a challenge, and forgetting to do so upon leaving became a trauma. Engaging with various Operational Creditors to verify their claims, speaking to Financial Creditors, and diplomatically managing tasks became routine.

The Insolvency and Bankruptcy Law differed significantly from other statutes. Its interpretations required an understanding of regulations to provide clarity. Taking control of a Corporate Debtor's company, once entirely in their hands, was now entrusted to us. Ensuring the smooth operation of the company and its employees became a task, where Section 19 of the Code often felt like a magical sword. Our grasp of the IBC even helped us win a Diwali Competition, emphasizing the role of law in our lives. The team at ASC exuded warmth and crazy energy, evident during the Diwali celebrations.

In summary, my nearly five month tenure taught me that with the right supportive people around, anything is achievable and of course with a lot if fun.




